

Directions to St Vincent's University Hospital

- **By Bus**

The numbers 7, 7A and 45 can all be boarded at O'Connell Street and pass St Vincent's Hospital on Merrion Road. The 45 runs from Corn Exchange Place and passes the hospital on Merrion Road. - **By DART**

- **By Train**

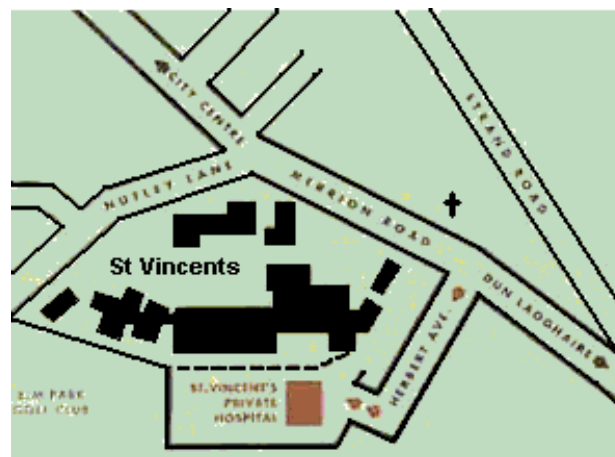
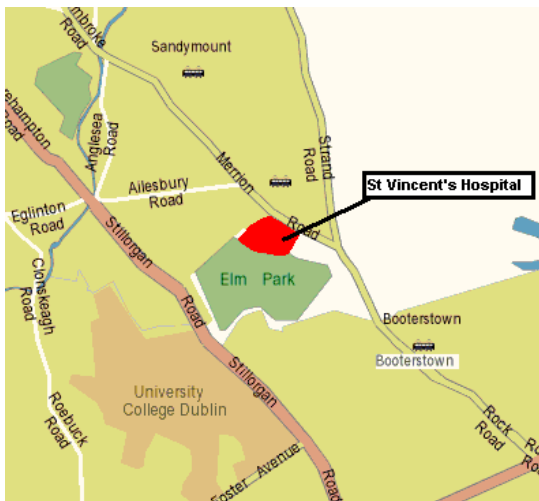
Dublin is served by two main railway stations: Connolly and Heuston. From Connolly Station is a short walk to O'Connell Street from where the numbers 7, 7A and 45 can be boarded, or you could connect to the Southbound DART (See above). There are frequent connecting services from Heuston to the city centre. For further information please see <http://www.irishrail.ie>

- **By Taxi**

It is possible to hail a taxi from the street, but convenient taxi ranks are located outside Wynn's Hotel on Middle Abbey Street and opposite the Bank of Ireland on Dame Street.

- **By Car**

Go to the main entrance of the hospital from Nutley Lane and ask to be directed to the Education & Research Centre. (It is the first right turn down the hospital corridor after the main reception desk at the Nutley Lane entrance and is signposted Education & Research Centre)
